

*Divergence in +/- indicators for percent/count change may indicate little overall change coupled with relatively wide annual fluctuation in case filings.

- On average, over 11,300 cases were filed with the 10th Circuit Court and FCC each year.
 - Although filings for several case categories increased, overall filings decreased by approximately 240 each year.
- By count, the largest increase in filings was in domestic relations cases, while the largest decreases were in traffic/ordinance and FCC cases.
- Traffic/ordinance cases accounted for over two-fifths of the court's caseload, while misdemeanor/etc. accounted for almost one-fifth, associate civil/small claims for one-sixth and domestic relations for one-eighth (see below).
