





- On average, over 17,200 cases were filed with the 32nd Circuit Court and FCC each year.
 - Filings increased over the 5-yr period by over 100 each year.
- By count, the largest increase in filings was in associate civil/small claims cases, while the largest decrease was in traffic/ordinance cases.
- Associate civil/small claims, misdemeanor/etc. and traffic/ordinance cases accounted for approximately one-fifth of the court's caseload each, while domestic relations accounted for approximately one-sixth (see below).
