

**IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF TANEY COUNTY

In Re: COVID-19

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have declared that the outbreak of COVID-19 is a worldwide pandemic, and national, state and local authorities have, accordingly, declared a state of emergency;

WHEREAS, the Missouri Supreme Court has instructed courts in this state to “prepare for potential infection in their community”;

WHEREAS, the Missouri Supreme Court has directed its courts to “consider strategies to prevent the spread of respiratory germs into, within, and between facilities.”

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, effective Monday, March 16, 2020, and until further order of this Court, that the following persons shall not enter the Taney County Courthouse, or any of its Divisions in Taney County, Missouri:

- Persons who have traveled to any foreign country within the last 14 days;
- Persons who reside or have had close contact with someone who has travelled to any foreign country within the last 14 days;
- Persons who have been asked to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital or health agency;
- Persons who have been diagnosed with, or have had contact with, anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19; and
- Persons with unexplained fever, cough or shortness of breath.

Anyone attempting to enter in violation of these protocols will be denied entry by a Court Security Officer. Individuals not authorized to enter the premises because of the restrictions listed above are provided the following contact information to have remote access to the administration of justice: Amy Strahan, Circuit Clerk of Taney County, Missouri, (417) 546-7230.

Any attorney or party shall promptly notify opposing counsel and the court if they reasonably suspect that a participant in any proceeding authorized by this Court’s Administrative Order may come within any of the above listed categories.

If you have a scheduled appointment or you are otherwise required to appear at one of the offices or divisions of this courthouse in Taney County, Missouri, and you are unable to appear because of the restrictions listed above, you should proceed as follows:


- If you are represented by an attorney, please contact your attorney;

- If you are an attorney scheduled to appear in Court before a Circuit or Associate Circuit Judge, please contact that Division Clerk by calling the Circuit Clerk's Office at (417) 546-7212;
- If you need information about the status of your case, please consult Casenet or contact the Circuit Clerk's Office at (417) 546-7212;
- If you are a prospective Juror, please contact (417) 546-7236;
- If you are seeking an Order of Protection regarding adult/child abuse please contact (417) 546-7212;
- If you are scheduled to meet with a Probation Officer, please contact Missouri Bench Probation Service at (417) 546-9640 or the Missouri Probation and Parole Office at (417) 334-5613;
- For Taney County Prosecuting Attorney matters, please contact the Taney County Prosecuting Attorney at (417) 546-7260;
- For Taney County Public Defender matters, please contact the Missouri Public Defender at (417) 895-6740;
- For Taney County Sheriff matters, please call the main line at (417) 546-7250;
- For Juvenile matters, please contact the Taney County Juvenile Office at (417) 546-7223.

These restrictions will remain in place temporarily until it is determined to be safe to remove them. People who think they may have been exposed to COVID-19 should contact their healthcare provider immediately.
